ARRIVE PARIS (2 NIGHTS) Discover romance, sophistication and French *joie de vivre* in Paris – the launch pad to a memorable journey through the French countryside. Explore the grand boulevards and winding lanes of the City of Lights, before meeting your Travel Director and companions for a Welcome Reception. We take to the streets this evening to see some of the city's most iconic sights, including the Champs Élysées and Arc de Triomphe, standing in all its glorious splendour for you to admire. PARIS SIGHTSEEING AND FREE TIME Join a Local Specialist to delve into the hidden squares and secret lanes of a Paris not normally frequented by tourists. LYON – AIX-EN-PROVENCE – MONACO – FRENCH RIVIERA (2 NIGHTS) Follow the

Rhône Valley south, enjoying some free time in Aix-en-Provence for a delicious lunch and the sweet flavours of *Calissons*, then stop in the glamourous Principality of Monaco bound for the sun-kissed shores of the French Riviera. View the Palace, which has been the home of the Grimaldis since the 13th century, and the cathedral where the late Princess Grace and Prince Rainier were married. This evening, we enjoy a delicious Regional Meal together in Monaco before arriving at our hotel, where we'll spend the next two nights. (**BB, RM**) **Hotel: Montaigne & Spa**

FRENCH RIVIERA FREE DAY Walk in the footsteps of the world's big stars, strolling along the stylish streets of Cannes on this day at leisure in the French Riviera. See the famous Palais des Festivals at the end of La Croisette, relax on the beach with the beautiful people, or visit the delightful hilltop town of Saint-Paul-de-Vence, a favourite haunt of the rich and famous. **(BB)**

Phoenician trading port. We arrive in the ancient city of Avignon, once the Seat of the Papacy, where we will spend the next two nights.
